Classic cars from across the Lower Mainland will be roaring into Ambleside Park in West Vancouver on Saturday, July 22, for Cruise the Shore, a fundraising event in support of the new Medical & Surgical Centre at Lions Gate Hospital in North Vancouver.

Dozens of classic cars will be on display along with lots of family-friendly activities, food truck eats and music.

Cruise the Shore is being hosted by members of the BC Hot Rod Association who wanted to support the campaign to bring a new facility to the Lions Gate campus. “We really just want to give back,” says event organizer Dan London. “My family has lived on the North Shore since the late 1890s and they benefitted from the old North Vancouver General and my sons were born at Lions Gate Hospital. Recently, a family member was a patient at Lions Gate and they also received treatment at other hospitals. Compared to the other facilities, the level of patient care they received at Lions Gate was above and beyond.”

Entry to Cruise the Shore is by donation. All proceeds will go directly towards the \$100 million campaign to build a new acute surgical centre on the Lions Gate Hospital campus.
